Project Aims

The Faculty of Public Health (FPH) undertakes a review of the specialty training curriculum approximately every 5 years to ensure that regulatory requirements are being met and that the curriculum is fit for purpose. A copy of the Current training Curriculum can be found here. It is intended that the product of this review will be presented to regulators for implementation in 2027.

Following changes for those working in Public Health, this is an appropriate time to undertake a review and make sure that the curriculum continues to be fit to train a specialised workforce that has the core Public Health specialist skills required to practice in a variety of settings.

The curriculum defines and describes the processes (learning methods and outcomes, induction, assessment and remediation), phases of training, and settings for learning.

This will be a substantive review following the 'light touch' 2020 review.

The aim of the Curriculum review will be to:

- Engage with stakeholders at all levels in public health during the review.
- Produce a new training curriculum to be presented and approved by the regulators; General Medical Council and the UK Public Health Register.
- To "go live" in summer 2027 with the approved training curriculum.

During the curriculum review the Curriculum & Assessment Committee (CAC) will become the Curriculum Review Working Group (CRWG), who will deliver the consultation process and produce a revised curriculum.

This work will be overseen by the Curriculum Review Steering Group (CRSG) on behalf of the Education Committee.

Project Deliverables

The Curriculum review will provide, through consultation mechanisms, the opportunity for stakeholders to feedback on changes that should be made to the curriculum.

These mechanisms for feedback will be online surveys and workshops to be held in the four nations and for those key groups that the Faculty will wish to address during the process.

This feedback will then be collated and analysed and, where appropriate, used as the basis of revisions for the Specialty Training Curriculum.

The key deliverables for the project will be:

- Circulation of an FPH Projects application to engage Registrars to take part in the drafting of new curriculum.
- Engage an external Educationalist to provide guidance on writing Learning Outcomes.
- A robust and thorough consultation process for key stakeholders in Public Health.
- A redrafted Curriculum, approved by the regulators, and published by August 2027.
- Additional documents for Registrars, Supervisors and Training Programme Directors in the use of the curriculum, including a mapping document for learning outcomes.
- An implementation plan for users, including mechanism for feedback and queries.
